LBS College of Engineering, Kasaragod

LBS Centre for Science & Technology, Thiruvananthapuram, the premier institution of computer training/consultancy and Engineering consultancy was established by the Government of Kerala in 1976. The Centre is administered by a Governing Body and an Executive Committee. The Hon'ble Chief Minister is the Chairman of the Governing Body and the Hon'ble Minister for Education is the Vice-Chairman. The Principal Secretary for Higher Education is the Chairman of the Executive Committee and the Director of Technical Education is the Vice-Chairman. There are two self-financing Engineering Colleges under LBS Centre viz. LBS College of Engineering, Kasaragod and, LBS Institute of Technology for Women, Thiruvananthapuram.

Applications in the prescribed proforma are invited from eligible candidates who secure the minimum eligibility criteria in the plus two or equivalent examination prescribed by the Kannur University. Candidates who have not appeared for the entrance examination are also eligible for admission.

PROFILE

The Campus

The campus is located at Muliya about 12 km from Kasaragod Railway station and 75 km from Mangalore Airport. Sprawling over an area of more than 50 acres, the campus is set in a sylvan environment. The close proximity of the campus to NH 17 and SH 31 makes it well connected to any part of the country. At the same time being located at the outskirts of the town makes the campus silent, serene and but lively to provide a conducive ambience for the pursuit of learning

The Curriculum

The College offers B.Tech Courses in six branches of Engineering viz Mechanical Engineering (ME), Electrical and Electronics Engineering (EEE), Electronics and Communication Engineering (ECE) Computer Science and Engineering (CSE), Information Technology (I.T) and Civil Engineering (CE).

World Bank Assistance (TEQIP)

The LBS College of Engineering Kasaragod is one among the six well performing colleges in Kerala, selected by National Project Implementation Unit (NPIU), Government of India to implement Technical Educational Quality Improvement Programme (TEQIP). The objective of this programme is to achieve academic excellence by modernizing existing laboratories, Workshops, Libraries, setting up of new laboratories with state of the art facilities, faculty and staff training etc.

The College has started implementing the programme with the allotted fund of Rs.6 crores for the first phase. The National Institute of Technology (NIT) Calicut is acting as the Lead Institute for this Programme so that the students and the faculty will get benefited by resource sharing, student and faculty sharing, joint research programme etc. which is envisaged between the Lead and the Network Institutions.

Activities

In order to give ample opportunities for the students and to develop their innate talents, they are encouraged to organize and participate in cultural, literary and sports events regularly. The NSS., Nature Club and Tourism Club are very active in the Campus thereby fostering a feeling of comradeship and unity among the students. The recently formed Debate Club, Mathematics Club and Quiz Club are acting as catalysts in the quest for knowledge among the students.

The facilities

All the Engineering Departments function in separate buildings equipped with well furnished laboratories and workshops made exclusively for the purpose. Every department has a full-fledged departmental library associated with it.

A well-stocked Central Library with a collection of more than 20,000 books and International/ National Journals, a modern Computer Centre and Internet Lab cater to various academic needs of the students. An open-air auditorium and a high-tech seminar hall provide facility for organizing cultural programme, symposia and other related activities. A very good canteen, and extension counter of Central Bank of India and two STD booths near the hostels are other amenities.

The Career Guidance and Placement Unit (CGPU)

This unit is formed to bring the students and industrial fraternity on a common platform, thereby enhancing the scope for gainful employment of students. The unit is headed by a senior faculty member with representation from both students and staff. The CGPU helps in arranging industrial trainings, group discussions, entrepreneurship training etc. More than 85% of outgoing students are getting placement in reputed National and Multi National Companies.

To ensure academic excellence, the College has employed regular qualified staff who fulfil all the AICTE norms for teaching in Engineering Institutions.

Eligibility

As per the prospectus issued by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Kerala for admission 2009-2010

Age

Applicant should complete 17 years of age as on 31-12-2009. No relaxation in the minimum age will be allowed. There is no upper age limit.

Selection

Selection of candidates will be based on the rank list prepared for the purpose observing the following criteria.

- a. Percentage of total marks obtained for the optional subjects.
- b. If there is a tie, the Percentage of marks for Mathematics will be counted
- c. If there is still a tie, Percentage of marks for Physics/Chemistry/total marks in the qualifying examination will be counted in sequences.

Fees and Refundable Deposit

1. The candidates selected will be required to remit an amount as annual tuition fee in lump at the time of admission as fixed by the Govt. of Kerala / LBS Centre for Science and Technology.
2. The candidates admitted against the NRI seats are also required to remit another amount at the time of admission as interest free refundable deposit as fixed by the Govt. of Kerala / LBS Centre for Science and Technology which shall be refunded on completion of 4 years or completion of the course whichever is later. The date of remittance of the deposit in the college will be considered for calculation of 4 years for refund of the refundable deposit.
3. In addition, the candidates will be required to remit the University fee, affiliation fee, special fee, establishment charges, PTA fee etc. as per instructions from the head of institutions from time to time.
4. The fees once remitted will not be refunded.

Fee and Deposit shall be paid in the form of DD issued in favour of Principal, LBS College of Engineering, Kasaragod.

Discontinuance of Course and levying of liquidated damages.

If any candidate admitted against NRI Seat discontinues the studies after the closing of admission for B.Tech Degree Course in the same academic year by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Kerala or in subsequent academic years he/she is liable to pay liquidated damages equal to the total fees payable for the remaining years of study. The refundable Deposit remitted by the student will also be forfeited.

How to apply

Application forms and admission conditions, can be had from the college on payment of Rs.500/- (Rupees Five Hundred only). The application can also be downloaded from the Website of LBS www.lbskerala.com and should be submitted along with a DD of Rs.500/-(Rupees Five Hundred only) favouring the Principal, LBS College of Engineering, Kasaragod payable at Kasaragod.

The filled up applications should reach the office of the Principal on or before **20/06/2009**

Documents to be submitted along with the application.

1. Nativity certificate (As per prospectus conditions issued by the CEE for admission to professional courses)
2. True copy of the SSLC/ equivalent certificates mentioning the date of birth of the applicant.
3. True copy of the qualifying examination certificate / marklist
4. NRI Certificate : Candidates may produce any one of the following certificates.
 - a. NRI Account no. (Certificates from the concerned bank)
 - b. Employment Certificate from the firm
 - c. Certificate from the Embassy concerned
5. Declaration of sponsorship from the NRI in the format attached with the application.

The admission to be made/made under NRI quota in the college will be subject to the direction/ orders issued by Government of Kerala in this regard.
